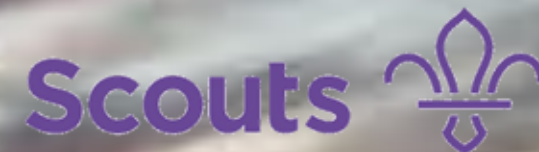
# Why Go Abroad with Scouts?

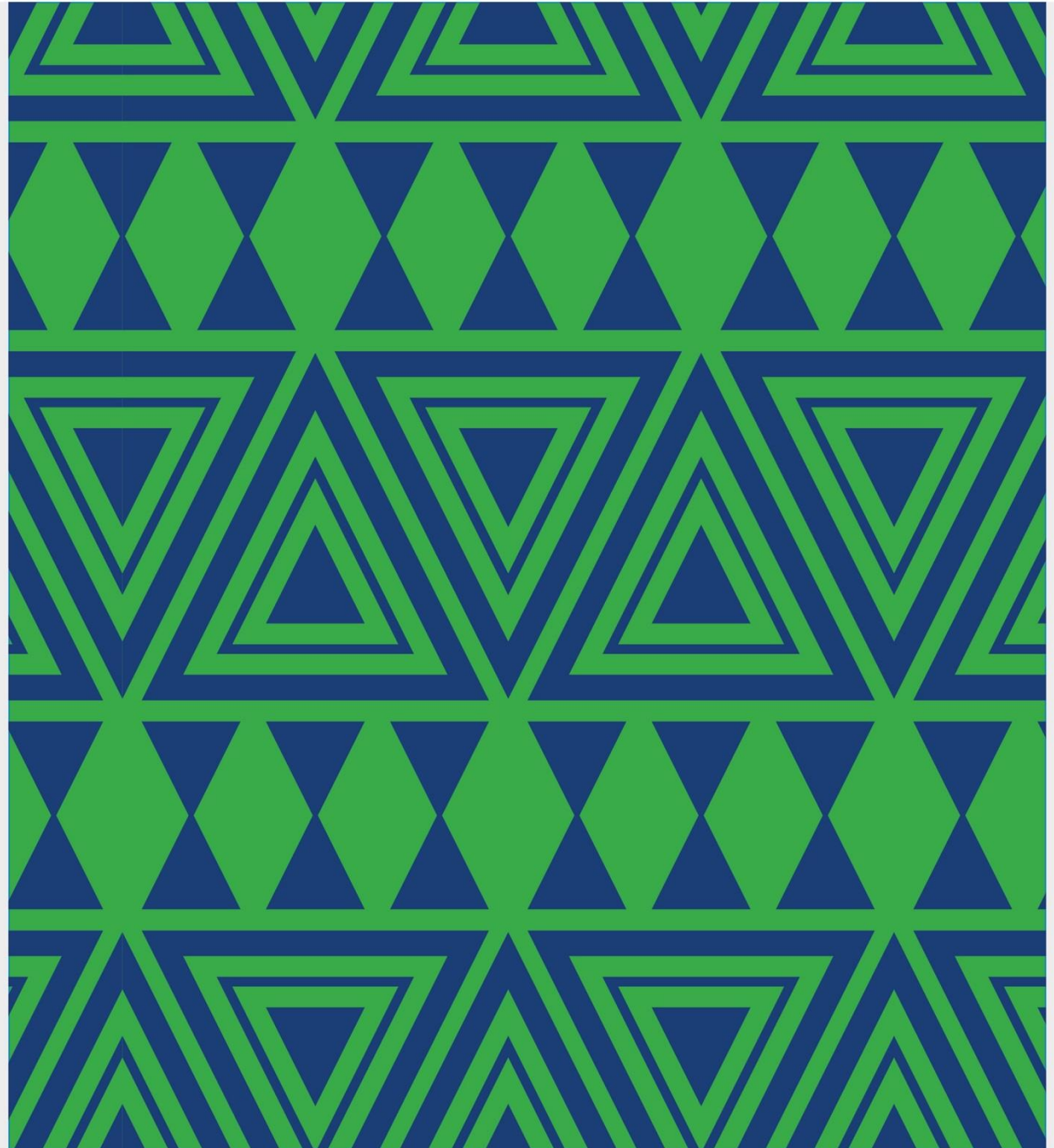

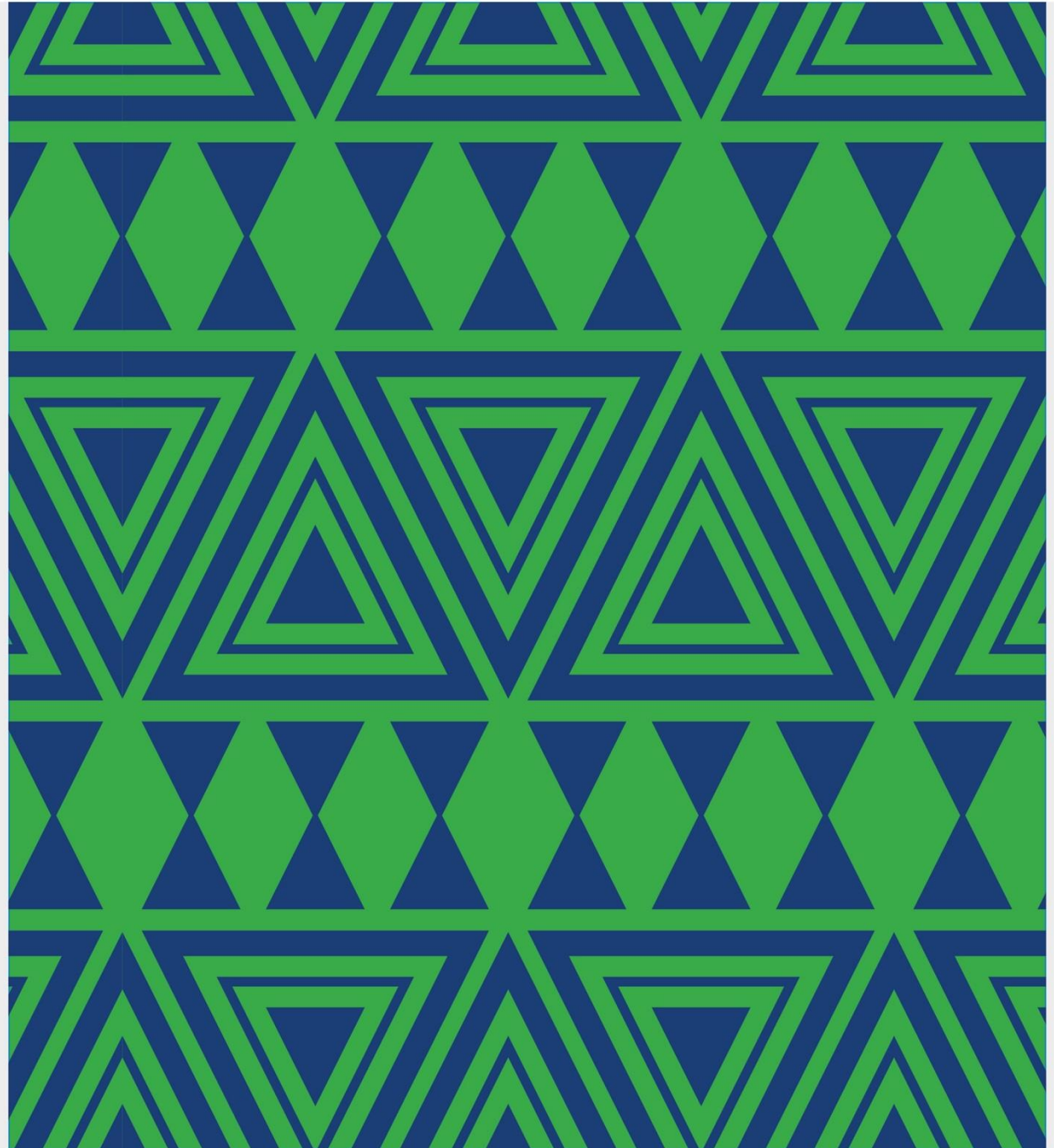

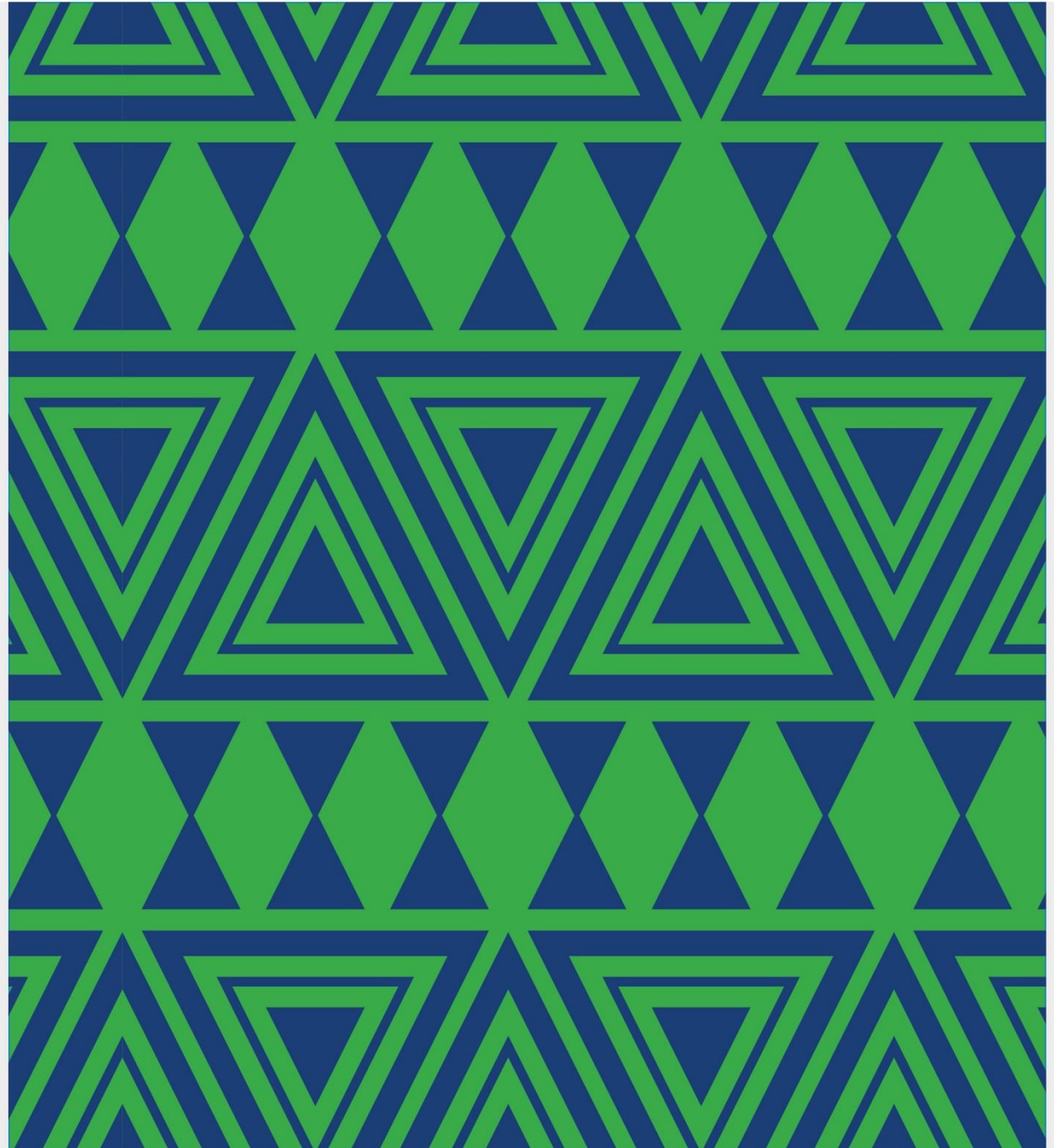
